- Stop the engine before refuelling. Do not refuel while hot. Avoid spillage of fuel when refuelling. Ensure the fuel cap is properly secured after refuelling. Carry out visual inspection for fuel leaks and repair before operation. Keep flammables away from the engine. Do not smoke while operating, servicing or refuelling this machine.
- The muffler is fitted with a heat shield. Let the engine cool down before attempting any maintenance. Avoid contact with hot components.
- Only operate in a well ventilated area. Do not operate in a confined space. Avoid breathing petrol fumes. Avoid skin contact with petrol.
- Hearing protection with a rating of 20db must be worn.

With both people firmly holding the machine open the throttle to commence drilling. Do not start the engine with the auger in the hole.

To clear the hole lift the machine and spin off the soil, do not lift the auger completely out of the hole.

To STOP return the throttle to low speed, turn OFF one of the stop switches

and turn off the fuel tap.
